How to create a class setup and add your pupils.

1. Log in to Teacher Mode (Teacher login).

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2. On the Welcome screen go to Manage setups.



3. If you are not logged in with your **Teacher ID** click **Identify to edit your setup** and log in.



4. Click the empty setup in the age band you class falls within. (Early Years, KS1 or K2)



- 5. Choose between a **Secure** and a **Basic** class. We recommend Secure as default.
- 6. Select **Registration group**, if you are setting up a class for pupils not yet registered on Busy Things. Select **Teaching group** if you want to create a setup for group of children that already belong to a class on Busy Things and have a Pupil ID.
- 7. Select **Manage owners** to allow other teachers configure and set work for your pupils. Select **Next**.
- 8. Give your class a name. Select **Next**.
- 9. Select the content level this can still be customised later. Select Next.
- 10. Select and icon and background. Select **Next**.
- 11. Only change the landing page if you want your class to access a single subject area. For new users we would recommend taking the default settings and clicking **Save**.
- 12. Select Add the pupils myself.
- 13. Select **Upload CSV file**. You will be asked to select which columns of your CSV to import. Select **Next**.
- 14. Select Correct capitals and shorten. Select Save.
